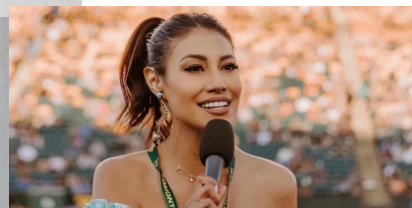


ASHLEY CALLINGBULL – Miss Universe Canada

Ashley Callingbull is an actress, model, host and First Nations activist from the Enoch Cree Nation. She is an actress on Blackstone, Tribal, The Great Salish Heist and was a contestant on the Amazing Race Canada. Ashley is also an international motivational speaker and has been a keynote speaker at Harvard University, TED Talks and WE Day.

Ashley's hard work and charity work was recognized as she received the Top 20 Under 30 Award in Canada and was named as one of Canada's Top 10 Power Women. Ashley received the Youth First Nations Award from Indspire which recognizes outstanding achievement across Turtle Island. Ashley was honoured to be inducted into the Circle of Honour at the Esquao Awards which recognizes Indigenous female leaders and activists. For her community work Ashley received the Role Model Award from the United Nations on Global Dignity Day. On the 70th Anniversary of Her Late Majesty, Ashley was awarded the Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee Medal for her dedication of public service to family, community and her country.

Ashley's journey embodies the strength, vision, and hope that the Drive 4 Food Golf Tournament strives to inspire in Indigenous youth. Through her achievements and advocacy, she continues to uplift communities and pave the way for future leaders. Her story is a powerful reminder of what is possible when young Indigenous voices are empowered and supported.

ETHAN BEAR

Ethan Bear is a proud member of the Ochapowace Nation in southern Saskatchewan whose journey reflects resilience, leadership, and excellence. A multi-sport athlete growing up, he advanced his hockey career at the Pursuit of Excellence Academy before being selected 25th overall by the Seattle Thunderbirds in the WHL Bantam Draft.

After returning home to limited training resources, Ethan remained focused on his goals and was later drafted in the 5th round (124th overall) by the Edmonton Oilers. At just 18, he was named to the WHL First All-Star Team and went on to earn WHL Defenseman of the Year honors in 2016–17. He achieved his dream of playing in the NHL in 2018, scoring his first goal that season.

In 2021, after facing racist messages online, Ethan used his platform to raise awareness about racism in hockey and to advocate for Indigenous youth. Today, he continues to inspire communities through speaking engagements and his foundation, supporting opportunity and food security initiatives. Ethan understands that success in sport—and in life—begins with access to basic needs. By strengthening food security in Indigenous communities, he reinforces his message that every young person deserves the nourishment, resources, and support to pursue their full potential.
